Wachter Horses is proud to offer beginner/intermediate riding lessons in addition to our competitive riding program. We feel that correct fundamentals are integral to ongoing success as riders move up the levels and we aim to provide such through our programming.

Right Start Riding is an all-inclusive riding program aimed at the beginner and intermediate rider of any age. Our mission is to facilitate the development of positive self-image and independence through the art of horsemanship. Lessons structure varies depending on each individuals' needs but can take the form of group or private lessons.

For the beginner rider, we feel that horsemanship goes beyond simply riding and we aim to share an all encompassing love for the horse by expanding lessons to include basic horsemanship: handling and grooming as well as tacking and untacking the horse. Safety is a top priority so appropriate riding apparel is mandatory.

Riding Apparel

Each student is expected to have an approved riding helmet, boots with a 1" - 1 ½" heel, and some sort of stretchy riding pant (breeches are ideal, however leggings are also appropriate). Gloves are optional.

If you are unsure about any of your equipment feel free to ask us any questions you might have.

Expectations

Clean up after yourself in the tack stall, hallway, or wash bay.

Return any brooms, shovels, or pitch forks to the location you removed them from.

Return tack to where it came from and put it away exactly how you found it.

Closed toes shoes are mandatory.

No smoking in the facility.

No raised voices or running in the barn to keep our horses feeling safe
